New Business

- A. Town Manager Shook presented the new, 4-year Sales Tax Reinvestment agreement between Caldwell County and Cajah's Mountain. The agreement lowered Cajah's Mountain's contributions from \$224,000 per year to \$155,000 per year. The Council approved the agreement unanimously on motion by Councilman Bolick and second by Councilwoman Pritchard.
- B. Town Manager Shook presented the findings of sufficiency for the voluntary annexation of 3357 Peachtree Place, Lenoir, NC 28645. The Council approved sending the application to the Planning Board for a rezoning recommendation. This approved unanimously on motion by Councilman Bolick and second by Mayor Pro Tem Stewart.
- C. Town Manager Shook presented the first reading of the 2017-2018 fiscal year budget before the Council. The Council agreed to look over the line items during their budget meeting following the Council meeting.
